

NON-MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

If you are in a dangerous or life-threatening situation (e.g. mugging, assault, break-in, traffic accident, domestic violence, abuse etc.), call the **emergency police number 110**. Be prepared to give the following information:

- Who are you?
- Where are you?
- What has happened?
- How many people are involved?

Follow the instructions given on the telephone and wait for the arrival of the **police**.

If you need to contact the police in a non-emergency situation, call: +49 6221 99 0.

MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

If you or someone with you is in a life threatening medical situation and needs immediate medical care, call the **emergency medical number 112**. Be prepared to give the following information:

- Who are you?
- Where are you?
- What has happened?
- What is the illness/injury?
- How many people are involved?

Follow the instructions given on the telephone and wait for the **arrival of the ambulance or emergency doctor**. If possible, remember to have your **health insurance card** with you.

URGENT MEDICAL CARE IN NON-EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

If it is outside regular doctors' hours and you or someone with you needs medical care that is not an acute emergency but cannot wait until your doctor is available, you can call the central hotline for locating the **out of hours urgent medical care center** in your area: **116117**.

If you are in Heidelberg, you can go directly to the **out of hours urgent medical care center (Ärztlicher Bereitschaftsdienst)**. No appointment is needed. Please make sure to take your **health insurance card** with you.

URGENT CARE CENTER AT THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

If your child needs urgent, out of hours medical care, you should go directly to the **children's hospital** (**Zentrum für Kinder- und Jugendmedizin**). No appointment is needed. Outside of the regular hospital hours, care will be provided by the children's emergency service (Notfallpraxis) which is in the same building. Please make sure to take your child's health insurance card.

There are several ways to locate the nearest emergency pharmacy:

- 1. call the Apothekenfinder: landline +49 800 0022833, mobile 22833.
- 2. send a text message with the postal code to **22833** and you will receive a text message with the nearest emergency pharmacy.
- 3. Download the **Apothekenfinder app** from the App Store, Google Play or Microsoft Store.
- 4. Download the **Mein Heidelberg app** and search under "Gesundheit" and "Apotheken."
- 5. Each pharmacy maintains an **up-to-date list of the nearest emergency pharmacy** in its window or near the entrance.

SEXUAL HARASSMENT, STALKING AND BULLYING

This section provides information about safety and prevention as well as about counselling and support services for cases of sexual harassment, stalking and bullying.

Sexual harassment

Sexual harassment is considered to be sexually motivated, unwanted actions that humiliate a person and violate his or her dignity. This includes unwelcome sexual actions and requests for such actions, unwanted physical contact of a sexual nature, comments of a sexual nature and/or unwanted exposure to pornographic materials.

Stalking

Stalking is a crime involving actions such as repeated watching, following or lying in wait for a person; unwanted communication by phone, email, mail, or notes; harassing or threatening a person or persons close to him/her; unwelcome gifts or ordering of goods.

Bullying

Bullying is systematic hostility, harassment or discrimination either among employees or by superiors. It is aided and abetted by stressful situations at work, which may be the result of excessive or too low demands being made on a particular employee or group of employees, of work organization processes or the behavior of superiors.

SAFETY AND PREVENTION

Frauen-Nachttaxi (Women's Night Taxi Service)

In order to travel safely at night, women and girls over 14 who live in Heidelberg can take advantage of the Frauen-Nachttaxi. Children under 14 years of age travel for free. You may need to show your passport or personal ID card. You must purchase tickets ahead of time from one of the Bürgeramter in the city or from the Bürgerservice at the city hall (Rathaus). Tickets costs **six Euro** per ride and are valid within the city limits of Heidelberg from **10 pm to 6 am**. You can use one ticket for up to four women or girls who are travelling in the same direction. The drivers wait at your destination to make sure that you reach the door. You can stop a taxi on the street or find one at a taxi stop. Not all taxi companies participate in the Frauen-Nachttaxi program so ask the driver before getting in whether your ticket will be accepted. You can also call a Frauen-Nachttaxi at +49 6221 302030.

Self-Defense

Luisa ist hier

"Luisa ist hier" is a service to help women who feel harassed, threatened or simply unsafe when out at a bar or club. If you are in such a situation, you can ask the bartender or staff of the club "Ist Luisa hier?" (Is Luisa here?). The question acts as a code to signal to the staff that you need help, which will then be provided with no questions asked.

The student councils (Fachschaften) at the following departments of Heidelberg University are taking part in this program: the English Department, the Geography Department, the Polical Science Department, the Department for Romance Laguages, the Department of Sociology, the Political Economy Department, and the Law Department.

Security escorts in Neuenheimer Feld

Beginning at dusk, female students and employees at the university or university hospitals in Neuenheimer Feld can request that security staff escort them to their residence, their bus or tram stop or to their workplace free of charge. The service can be requested at the hospital reception desks (the desks at the Chirurgische Klinik, the Kinderklinik, the Kopfklinik, the Innere Medizin, and the DKFZ are staffed 24 hours) or by telephone at +49 6221 54 5555.

At night it is also possible to exit the bus between stops on the lines 31 and 32 in Neuenheimer Feld. You simply need to ask the bus driver ahead of time.

Date rape drugs

Date rape drugs are any type of drugs or alcohol that are used intentionally to enable sexual assault or rape. Many of these drugs affect their victims quickly and cause weakness, confusion, dizziness, and sometimes extreme euphoria. Victims often pass out and then do not remember what happened. Date rape drugs exist as pills, liquids, or powders, are often tasteless and without odor and can therefore easily be added to a drink or to food without the victim noticing. You can protect yourself by not accepting drinks from others, not sharing drinks, watching your drink, and going out in groups and looking out for each other. If you suspect that you have been given a date rape drug, get help immediately and call an ambulance or the police.

IMPORTANT: IF YOU SUSPECT YOU WERE EXPOSED TO DATE RAPE DRUGS

If you suspect that you have been given a date rape drug, you should be tested as soon as possible, because such drugs can be detected only for a short period of time.

SUPPORT AND COUNSELLING

If you are experiencing sexual harassment, stalking or bullying either at the university or in your private life, do not hesitate to seek assistance and support. There are several offices and organizations both at the university and in the city of Heidelberg that provide information and counselling.

IN THE CASE OF SEXUAL ASSAULT

If you have been sexually assaulted or raped, do not hesitate to seek medical and psychological support and to press charges against the perpetrator. The following information can help you to find out how to proceed so that evidence can be collected and charges can be pressed, if you wish:

- Do not bathe or shower before being examined by a doctor.
- You should also not wash your clothing.
- You have the right to ask to be examined by a female doctor. The doctor will do a pregnancy and HIV test.

The "**Gewaltambulanz**" is an institute at the university hospital that secures and preserves evidence in cases of violent crimes. They provide this service even if charges have not been pressed with the police. If you have been sexually assaulted or raped, you may be sent there by a doctor or you can also go to the "Gewaltambulanz" on your own. Reporting to the police: You can file a criminal complaint with the police around the clock.

LOSS OF IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS OR POSSESSIONS

Your passport

If you lose your passport, you should file a report at the **local police** station because a police report will most likely be required when you apply for a new passport. You should then contact **your country's embassy or consulate** to apply for a replacement. Most countries also provide information on their websites about the procedure for replacing a lost or stolen passport.

Your credit or debit card

If you lose a credit or debit card, you should immediately contact the bank that issued the card to notify them of the loss and have your card deactivated. Most banks provide a 24-hour hotline service for lost or stolen cards – this information is generally available on your credit card or bank statement. There is also a general cancellation hotline (Sperr-Notruf) through which you can cancel most credit and debit cards as well as some mobile SIM cards and other services.

Other possessions (lost and found office)
